2. Explanation of why the commodity is the only one that can meet the needs of the Agency:

Instead of running one test at a time, this technology allows for multiplex testing, meaning a single biochip can be used to run dozens of related tests at a time.

3. Explanation of why the source is the only person or entity that can provide the required commodity:

RANDOX is the only supplier of the RABTA analyzer and does not sell through secondary distributors. RANDOX holds all applicable patents or patents which have been applied for. RABTA analyzer has registered patents in the United States of America under patent number US 6498010. No other manufacturer offers an equivalent system with the same testing range, speed, and compact design. The nanotechnology methods and other manufacturing steps have several other patens as well.

4. Explanation of why the amount to be expended for the commodity is reasonable:

Objection to Sole Source Justification

- Interested parties must present specific objections to the Sole Source certification, including, but not limited to the following:
 - a) A description of the commodity or commodities that Interested Party believes is comparable to the Randox RABTA Analyzer
 - b) An explanation of why Interested Party's commodity or commodities can also meet the needs of the agency; and
 - c) A list of sources from which Interested Party's commodity may be procured.
- If Interested Party claims that the Randox RABTA Analyzer is available from a source other than RANDOX, the objection must contain a written statement from RANDOX that the Interested Party is an authorized distributor or reseller of the Randox RABTA Analyzer.

This information should be provided no later than Wednesday, October 29, 2025, at 5:00 pm local time. Response may be delivered by hand, via regular mail or overnight delivery.

If after a review of the submitted notice and documents, MSFL determines that the commodity in the proposed sole-source request can be provided by another person or entity, then MSFL will withdraw the sole source request publication from the procurement portal website and submit the procurement of the commodity or commodities to an advertised competitive bid process.

If MSFL determines after the review that there is only one (1) source for the required commodity or commodities, then MSFL will appeal to the Public Procurement Review Board. MSFL will have the burden of proving that the commodity or commodities is only provided by one (1) source.
