# **Course Description**

Crimes against children are some of the fastestgrowing crimes in our communities, committed against the most vulnerable in our society and are the toughest to bring to trial. These crimes can leave victims with lifelong adversities that are hard to overcome.

This course emphasizes a trauma-informed, victim-centered approach to child abuse investigations grounded in multidisciplinary team collaboration, ensuring that children are protected, investigations produce legally sound and prosecutable cases, and long-term healing and restoration is achieved for victims.



Legal statutes and investigative best practices for all forms of child maltreatment, including physical abuse, neglect, psychological abuse, torture, sexual abuse and exploitation, commercial sexual exploitation of children, internet crimes against children, child homicides, and missing endangered child cases.



#### Felony indicators of abuse

Recognizing and understanding the physical, developmental, emotional, and behavioral indicators of abuse applicable to felony child abuse and neglect statutes



#### **Legal Statutes**

Identifying and utilizing relevant legal statutes, and definitions to achieve successful prosecutions of child abuse cases.



#### Offender Characteristics

Understanding offender risk factors, profiles. and characteristics



# Trauma informed and forensically sound interviews

Conducting forensically sound interviews with children, suspects, and collateral witnesses.



# Evidence collection and case development

Investigative best practices in gathering, preserving, interpreting, and presenting medical, developmental, physical, digital, and other types of evidence.



#### Legal Issues

Understanding common legal issues in child abuse cases, preparing for court, delivering credible testimony, and overcoming common challenges in prosecution.
