The Chaplain Team Lead mentors and supports the team, delivers direct spiritual care to families, and staff, and addresses their diverse needs through counseling. They also connect the organization with the community, religious groups, and other interested parties. This position will oversee and manage all aspects of assigned spiritual care services and programs to meet the needs of the agency and community. Monitoring and improving the quality of spiritual care services is essential, using data and feedback for program enhancement.
