About the Position:

This Lieutenant will serve as direct supervisor of the Dispatcher Team Leads. Will be responsible for maintaining NIBRS compliance, 911 mapping and Dispatcher training. Thorough knowledge of CAD and RMS systems is required of this position. A working knowledge of the bodycam and in-car camera systems, as well as the license plate reader (LPR) systems, is preferred.

- **Minimum Qualifications**: Minimum of seven (7) years *certified* law enforcement experience with a Municipal, County, or State Agency in an enforcement position. Law enforcement certificate must be in good standing with the Board on Law Enforcement Standards and Training (BLEOST). Must currently serve as a Lieutenant at MS State Capitol Police.
