- **Position:** Warrants Division Lieutenant – Law Enforcement Team Lead
- **Closing Date:** Friday, September 6, 2024, at 1700 hours (5:00PM)
- **Salary:** \$68,000 to \$70,000
- **Hours:** 12-hour shift. Must be able to adjust work hours as needed.
- **Location:** Jackson, MS
- **About the Position:** The Warrants Division Lieutenant will oversee daily activities of Warrants officers and other personnel. Provide guidance, direction and supervision to ensure that all officers perform their duties effectively and in accordance with department policies. Develop operational plans and implement strategies to execute those plans in a manner that ensures public safety. Coordinate with other agencies to accomplish tasks, as needed. Respond to major incidents, emergencies or critical incidents. Take command of the scene, manage resources, and make decisions to ensure public safety and effective law enforcement. Review and approve reports submitted by subordinate officers. Address any policy violations or misconduct and administer disciplinary actions when necessary.
- **Minimum Qualifications:** Minimum of seven (7) years *certified* law enforcement experience with a Municipal, County, or State Agency in an enforcement position. Minimum of one (1) year supervisory experience in a specialized unit. Law enforcement certificate must be in good standing with the Board on Law Enforcement Standards and Training (BLEOST).
- **Selection Process Includes:**
 1. Board Interview
 2. Recommendation(s) to Chief of Police
