LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AFFIDAVIT PART II

I, the undersigned, do hereby swear and affirm that I am the head of, or authorized representative for, the law enforcement agency identified above and that I have reviewed the employment and service records of the applicant identified herein.

I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, the applicant named below:

- Holds a current and valid Mississippi part-time law enforcement certification issued by BLEOST;
- Currently serves in a part-time capacity in one of the following positions, or other position approved by the Board:
 - As an instructor in a Board-approved academy or as an instructor or student in criminal justice or a related field at an institution of higher learning; or
 - As an investigator for a district attorney or as an investigator for a state agency responsible for enforcement of criminal statutes; or
 - As a municipal police officer, county deputy sheriff, or other law enforcement officer appointed or employed in a recognized political subdivision of any state, province, or territory of the United States who:
 - Is vested with authority to bear arms and make arrests; and
 - Has a primary duty of the prevention and detection of crime, apprehension of criminals, and enforcement of criminal or traffic laws.
- Has completed a minimum of five (5) consecutive years of qualifying service as a part-time law enforcement officer;
- Has performed a minimum of forty (40) duty hours per month during the qualifying five-year period;
- Has remained in good standing with this agency during the qualifying period; and
- Meets all eligibility requirements established by BLEOST for participation in the Part-Time to Full-Time Bridge Program.

Further, I certify that the information contained in this affidavit is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief and is supported by agency records maintained by this agency.
